Four are college students at the University of Washington, while one of the girls works at a large department store. The young people find themselves in a lively debate of issues related to global warming and alternative fuels. They argue vigorously about ethanol, solar and wind energy, and other means of avoiding fossil fuels that contribute to global warming. Colorful characterization adds dramatic flair to the debate, and a budding romance adds humanity. Peter advocates for establishment of 50 power grids nationwide instead of six. He promotes use of solar panels on every roof, and use of ethanol and biodiesel, plus increased use of public transportation. He displays a quirkiness in which he paces, jumps, and gestures wildly. His passion for the cause is extreme. In a discussion of terrorism Peter asserts that self-sufficient citizens are less vulnerable in the event of an emergency. People who live simply, he asserts, will be...
